Our New Auburn UMC loose coin will be going to the New Auburn After School Lunch Program. Thank you so much for your generosity.


Bloomer Loose Coin

...Pop tabs...They will be given to Ronald McDonald House Charities to help raise money so the people that need to stay there are able to do it



Progressive Live Nativity



<u> A Thank You From Michelle</u>


